Please do not allow your children to bring electronic devices in to school, this includes mobile phones.

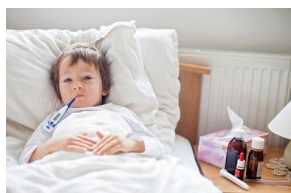
PARENTLINE

The ParentLine number is a text number only. It cannot receive phone calls. This number is confidential and is for use by parents and carers of children at Primary schools in Lambeth and Southwark.

ParentLine is a messaging service for parents and carers of children at schools in Lambeth and Southwark. Parents and carers can message a school nurse to get confidential advice about their child's health related issues. They would then reply to your query by text.

The service is available Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm year round, including the school holidays (excluding bank holidays). Texts will be responded to within one working day (an automatic bounce-back will be sent if a message is received out of hours but someone will respond once the service opens).
