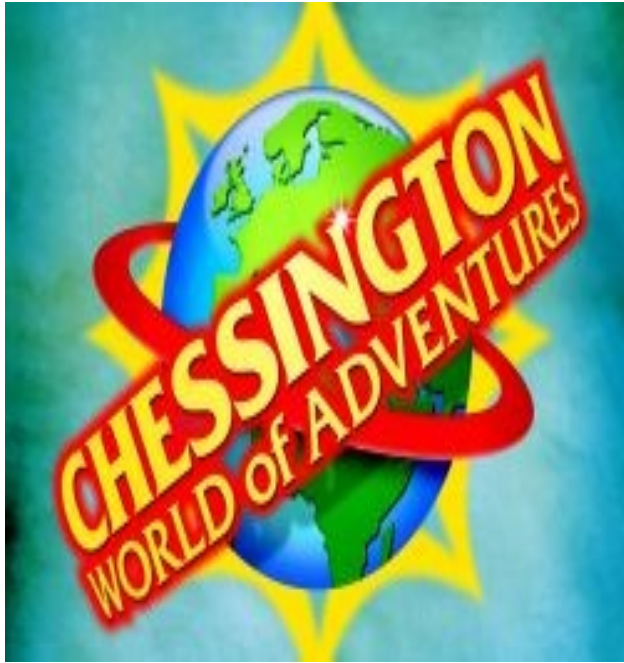


Chessington World of Adventure
