Peddle My Wheels

Try Before You Bike scheme for adults and children

This is a fantastic new initiative to promote cycling and makes owning a bike so affordable and easy. Here's how:

Order a bike through the website using the filter system to choose the right bike for you (peddlemywheels.com)

They deliver the bike and give you a free two hour cycle skills session to help with basic maintenance and cycle safety (adults only as children covered at school)

You pay from under £10 per month for kids bikes, from under £20 per month for adult bikes and from under £50 a month for an electric bike + any accessories you might want

You continue paying until you own it
Cycling not for you? Cancel anytime and they collect the bike with nothing further to pay

They will also collect, service and sell any child bike free of charge when it is replaced by a bike ordered through them
