You are invited to a **Community Question Time on Prevent/ Islamophobia** on 18th July at Iqra Primary School, 127 Park Hill, London SW4 9PA. The evening will start at 6.00 pm with food and continue until around 8.30 pm.

Since 2015, schools and local authorities have had a legal duty to have due regard to the need to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism. This is known as the 'Prevent Duty'. There has been some uncertainty among parents and communities about what is involved. There are also wider issues stemming from Prevent along with various other challenges faced by the Muslim community in particular which need addressing.

The event is organised by Faiths Together in Lambeth. You will be able to put your views and ask questions about Prevent/ Islamophobia and discuss concerns you might have.

The Lambeth Prevent staff Rupert Sutton (Prevent Programme Manager) and Lydia Nixon (Schools Prevent Officer) along with a representative from the Home Office will be present to answer your questions.
